



7 - Days Lake Mbuoro and Queen Elizabeth National Park and Lake Bunyonyi Family Trip

Day 1 : Pick up and Transfer to Lake Mbuoro National Park

You will be picked up from your location in Kampala in the morning, briefing and transfer to Lake Mbuoro National Park. Upon entering the park through Nshara Gate, a game drive en-route will be a rewarding activity which will enable you to encounter many of the Park's flora and fauna with most wildlife grazing side by side with the Ankole domestic Cattle.

Afternoon lunch before you proceed for a 2 hours boat ride on Lake Mbuoro in the afternoon which will get you quite close to Crocodiles and Hippos. Dinner and overnight at lodge.

Day 2 : Morning Game drive and afternoon boat cruise

After an early breakfast, you will go for a morning game drive in the park where you will be able to view animals when they are most active. During the morning game drive you will be rewarded with great views of animals like buffaloes, zebras, impalas, elands, topi, warthogs, waterbucks, giraffes and many others which will be grazing in the open savannah plains, view different bird species, tree species among others. After the game drive you will return back to the lodge for lunch.

After lunch you will go for an interesting boat cruise on Lake Mbuoro where you will be able to view hippos in water, Nile crocodiles basking on the banks, animals like buffaloes, warthogs, antelopes drinking water along the shores, view water birds like the rare shoebill stork, hornbills, kingfishers, bee-eaters, fish eagles, dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 3 : Transfer to Queen Elizabeth National Park

You will have a relaxed breakfast, checkout of your lodge for a transfer to Queen Elizabeth National Park. You will enjoy perfect viewing along the way. You will



arrive on time for lunch. check-in to your lodge have lunch.

later will head for an evening game drive to view more animals like buffaloes, elephants, warthogs, Uganda kobs, water-bucks and more. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 4 : Game drive, boat Cruise at Queen Elizabeth National Park

Go for an early morning game drive in Queen Elizabeth national park where you will spot a lot of wildlife including African elephants, buffaloes, antelopes, impala, among others and a lot of birds. Return to the lodge for breakfast, relax a bit and enjoy your lunch.

In the afternoon, go for a launch cruise along the Kazinga channel inside Queen Elizabeth Park where you will come up close with hippos, crocodiles among other aquatic life and an array of birds on the bay! Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight as above.

Day 5: Chimpanzee tracking and transfer to lake Bunyonyi

Have an early morning breakfast, and transfer to Kyambura gorge which is situated in the eastern part of Queen Elizabeth national park. Upon arrival you will proceed to the headquarters where you will be briefed about chimpanzee trekking, allocated a chimpanzee family to trek and a park guide who is well conversant with trails in the gorge. Chimpanzee trekking in Kyambura gorge takes about 30 minutes to 4 hours depending on where the chimpanzees slept the previous night, during trekking you will have great views of other primates, bird species, plants, colorful butterflies among others. Once the chimpanzees are found you will be able to spend one hour with them in their habitat where you will be able to observe their behaviors, watch them feed, play, fight, hunt, rest,

Later return to your lodge for lunch and checkout for a transfer to Lake Bunyonyi in Kabale. Lake Bunyonyi is the second deepest lake in Africa and it harbors 29 islands and a range of bird species. The journey takes about 6 to 7 hours' drive and upon arrival you will check into the lodge for dinner and overnight.



Day 6: Canoeing and boat cruise and cultural walk at lake Bunyonyi

After breakfast, visit the distinctive Batwa and Abaheesi (black smiths) societies or to the Bukora Cave. Have lunch at the resort and use the afternoon or evening for a boat ride, canoeing or go for a cycling tour of the area, going to Orugano Rain Forest which has diverse plants and animals and some community tourism through interaction with the Batwa (pygmies) who inhabit parts of the forest and its surrounding areas. Dinner and overnight stay at Bunyonyi Safari Resort, Bunyonyi Overland Resort or Arcadia Cottages.

Day 7: Transfer back to Kampala

After breakfast, start your drive back to Kampala stopping in Mbarara town for lunch. Then proceed to Kampala and arrive in the evening.
